Section 8-75 exempts buildings from moving permits if the building does not exceed 16' in width or 24' in length. An additional requirement for that exemption needs to be that the loaded height of the building does not exceed 14' in height.

#1 - When the building is greater than 16' in width, 24' in length, or 14' in loaded height then a permit is required and the following City Department signatures are required before a permit will be issued: Police, Fire, Utility, Public Works, and Parks.

#2 - When the building to be moved is in excess of 14' loaded height then, in addition to the signatures listed above, the telephone and cable company signatures will be required.

#3 - When the building to be moved is in excess of 34' wide and the route includes passage across railroad property then the applicable railroad company signature shall be required in addition to the other signatures.
